Hazardous unsafe air quality and conditions due to fire in the San Bernardino and Highland area. Soot and ash are causing extremely difficult and hazardous breathing conditions. The Slide Fire is currently out of control in an area that is adjacent to the City of San Bernardino and the San Bernardino area courthouses. Currently there is no estimate for containment.

The following court buildings and court operations are adversely impacted and the anticipated duration of suspension of court operations and court closures is from 1:00pm, Wednesday, October 24 through close of business on Thursday, October 25, 2007.
